

Temple University Professor Marc Lamont Hill Praises Palestinian-Arab Bomber Who Tried to Murder As Many As 1,200 Israelis; Laments Her Death

On November 4, 2022, **Marc Lamont Hill**, the **Steve Charles** Professor of Media, Cities, and Solutions on the faculties of Temple University's Lew Klein College of Media and Communication and Temple's College of Education and Human Development, posted multiple tweets (see next page) mourning and praising would-be mass-murderer **Fatima Bernawi**.

In 1967 **Bernawi** planted a bomb under a seat of Jerusalem's Zion Cinema, a 600-seat venue. The timer on the bomb was set to explode the bomb in-between screenings of a film marking Israel's miraculous victory in the Six Day War — thus it would have killed people leaving the previous showing as well as those waiting to enter for the next screening, plus employees and even passers-by in the busy area. Miraculously the bomb — which had been placed inside a handbag — was noticed and was removed by police just before it exploded, sparing massive casualties and injuries. Bernawi was arrested and convicted and served time in Israeli prison. **Yasser Arafat** and **Mahmoud Abbas** are among the others who praised Bernawi over the years.

Hill paid tribute to a would-be mass-murder of Jews during a period of dramatic increase in attacks against Jewish people and institutions, accompanied by open, unbridled incitement of hatred and resentment against Jews by influencers from throughout the political spectrum. Hill's positions and his activities in the public spotlight make Hill an influencer of future schoolteachers and future journalists, and to the nation-at-large.

Hill has previously falsely accused Jews of poisoning the water supply of Palestinian-Arabs, and of training U.S. law-enforcement officers to murder African-Americans in cold blood on America's streets. Hill has called for violence, claiming that non-violent protests alone will not get the job done for the Palestinian-Arabs in their war against Israel. Hill has also called for the destruction of Israel — asserting that Israel should be replaced by a "Palestine" "from the river to the sea" — a scenario that would likely result in the murders of hundreds of thousands of Jewish people.

At present, **Marc Lamont Hill** hosts shows on **Al Jazeera**, **The Griot**, and **Quake** networks, and is published by **Atria Books** (a division of **Simon & Schuster**). **The Free Library of Philadelphia** frequently has Hill as a guest speaker and event moderator.

Hill has over the years posted multiple photos of himself with Ali Jiddah, whom he has written about effusively.

Jiddah had planted four grenades on Strauss Street in downtown Jerusalem in 1968, according to the *Times of Israel*.

Jiddah's bombs exploded and injured nine Israelis.

Action Items:

Please contact the individuals and/or companies below about Marc Lamont Hill's continuing Jew-hatred and incitement, and his latest attack: Praising a would-be mass-murderer of potentially more than 1,000 Jewish civilians.

Ask if the school or business or institution admires Hill and his anti-Jewish activities, and whether or not the institution or business should have such an individual on their faculty; on their network; or given a platform by a city government library or a publisher. Remind who you contact that promoting Jew-hatred, violence against Jews, and someone who attempted the mass-murder of Jews is heinous and beyond the pale of civil society — and that Marc Lamont Hill represents the school or business and is associated with those entities by the public.

Please be mindful that whenever you engage in advocacy to be polite, civil and concise.
